Directions: From Tewkesbury, go to Winchcombe and follow B4078 south from town centre. On the edge of the town turn left into a lay-by and left on Corndean Lane uphill. Keep on this lane for just under 4 miles and then turn left (after a left turn to Charlton Abbots) sp. Brockhampton. In village turn left at telephone kiosk sp Memorial Rhodes Hall. Turn left after the hall and cottage (before lane turns sharp right) and immediately left into the small car park. Please share cars if possible. We are allowed to park there free.

Details: A circular walk at a gentle pace, on quiet lanes, a drovers track, bridleway and fields to Sevenhampton church. A gentle climb at the start with one short steeper uphill on a lane and one on a field path, a steep downhill, otherwise undulating. Good views, 2 stiles, not difficult (which can be avoided by missing the church and walking the last part along the lane to Brockhampton instead of the field path).

Directions From Tewkesbury: Head south on the M5, turn off at Junction 13 taking the 3rd exit onto the A419. At the roundabout take the first exit onto the A38 Bristol Road. After 0.5 miles turn right onto Perry Way B4071. After 1.5 miles you will arrive at Frampton on Severn, turn left onto The Green, after 0.4 miles turn left onto Watery Lane, continue to the car park.

Details: A scenic circular walk from Frampton on Severn to Saul Junction along 2 canals, crossing 4 bridges and seeing many river boats and barges. An easy 3 mile walk mostly along footpaths, flat terrain, no stiles. Optional stop at the Stables Café, Saul
