**Directions** Turn off to the left from the A46 at Hinton Green, as you approach Evesham

and bear right to stay on Elmley Road until you reach a T Junction, turn left and

you will see the pub at the top end of the road on the right. Please park

considerately on the road running up to pub. Not immediately outside Pub due

to bus movements.

It is also possible to approach from Ashton-under-Hill in which case when you reach Elmley the pub will be immediately in front of you. If coming west about the Hill find your way through Great Comberton and then Little Comberton

following signs to Elmley Castle.

**Details** The walk takes us to Little Comberton Church and then across fields to

Bricklehampton churchyard and then back to our start. Depending on the weather there are views over the vale and back up to the slopes of Bredon Hill. This walk is mostly on field margins with a short walk along a road into Little Comberton. There are no stiles! Some of the bridges across the streams might be slippery if wet and, some slippery patches of mud. Waterproof boots recommended as wet grass. Watch out for hidden rutted tracks and rabbit

**Directions** In Bredon take the B4080 towards Pershore and Eckington. Take the 2nd road on the right (signposted Bredons Norton) Carry on through village to traffic island, the bus shelter is to the right. There is limited road side parking, mainly to the North of the church.
